

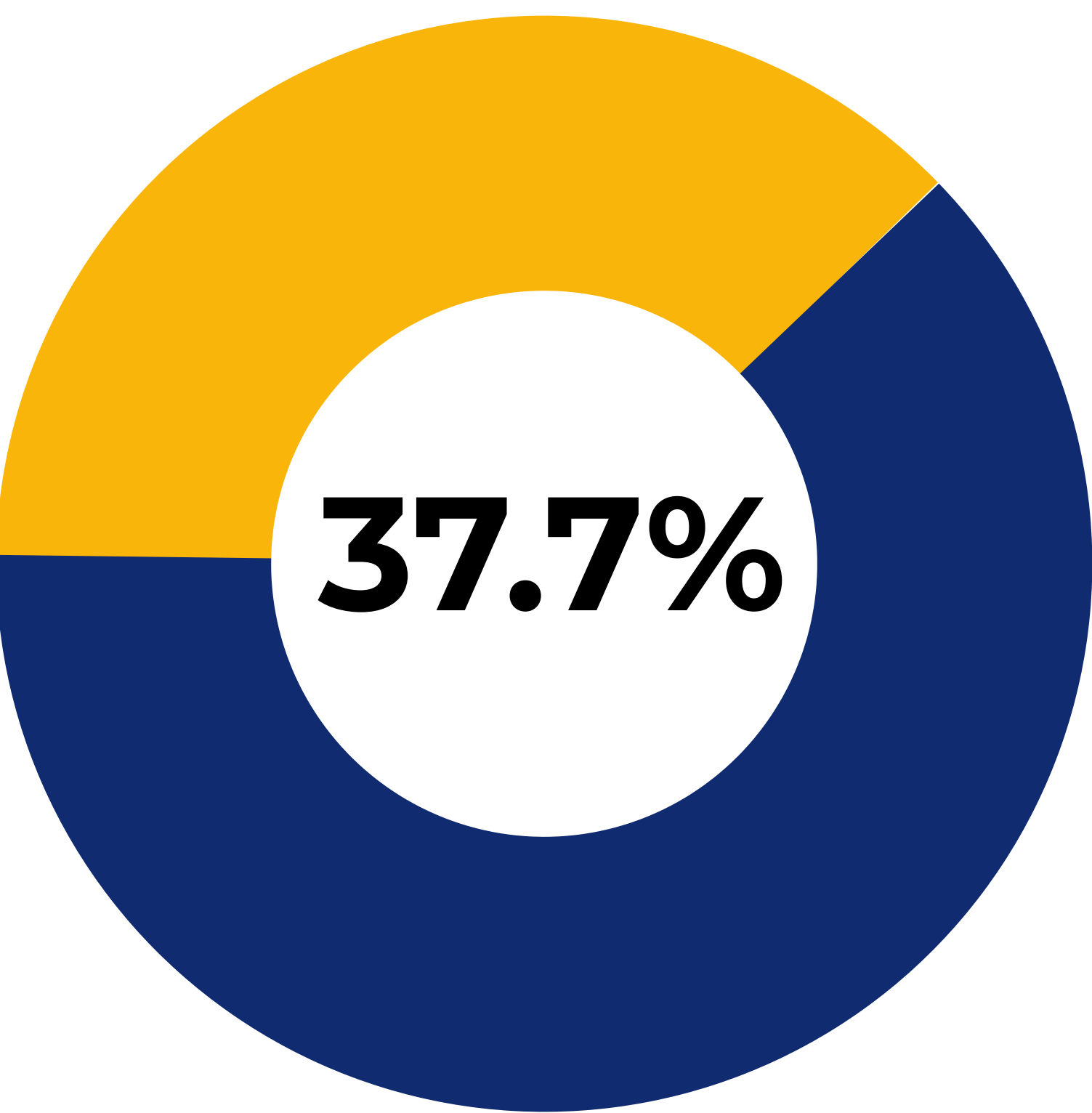

Trigg County

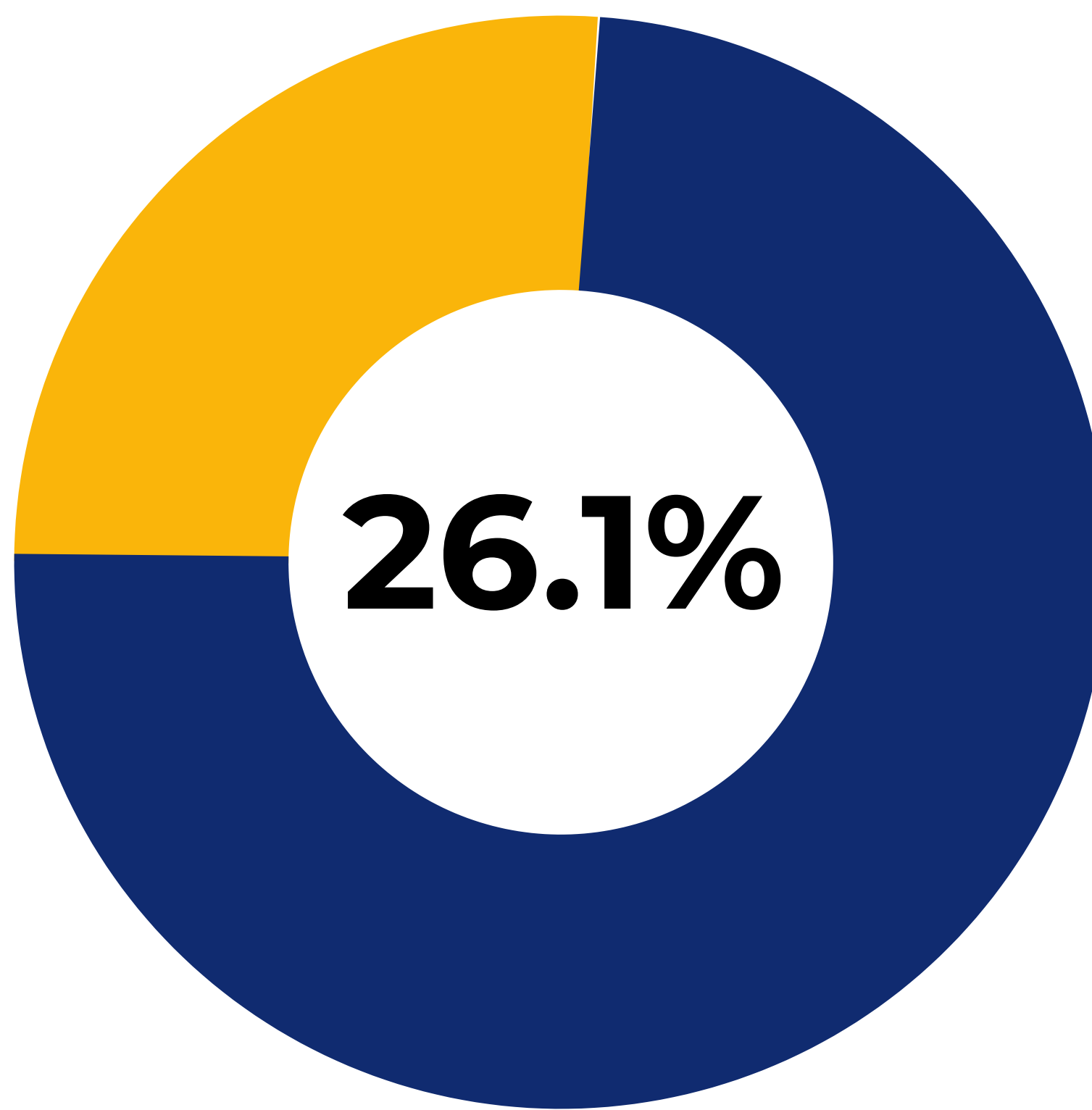
Every county's economy is unique and that means every county has a unique tax structure. In FY2018, Trigg County collected \$2,751,468 in revenue from taxes.

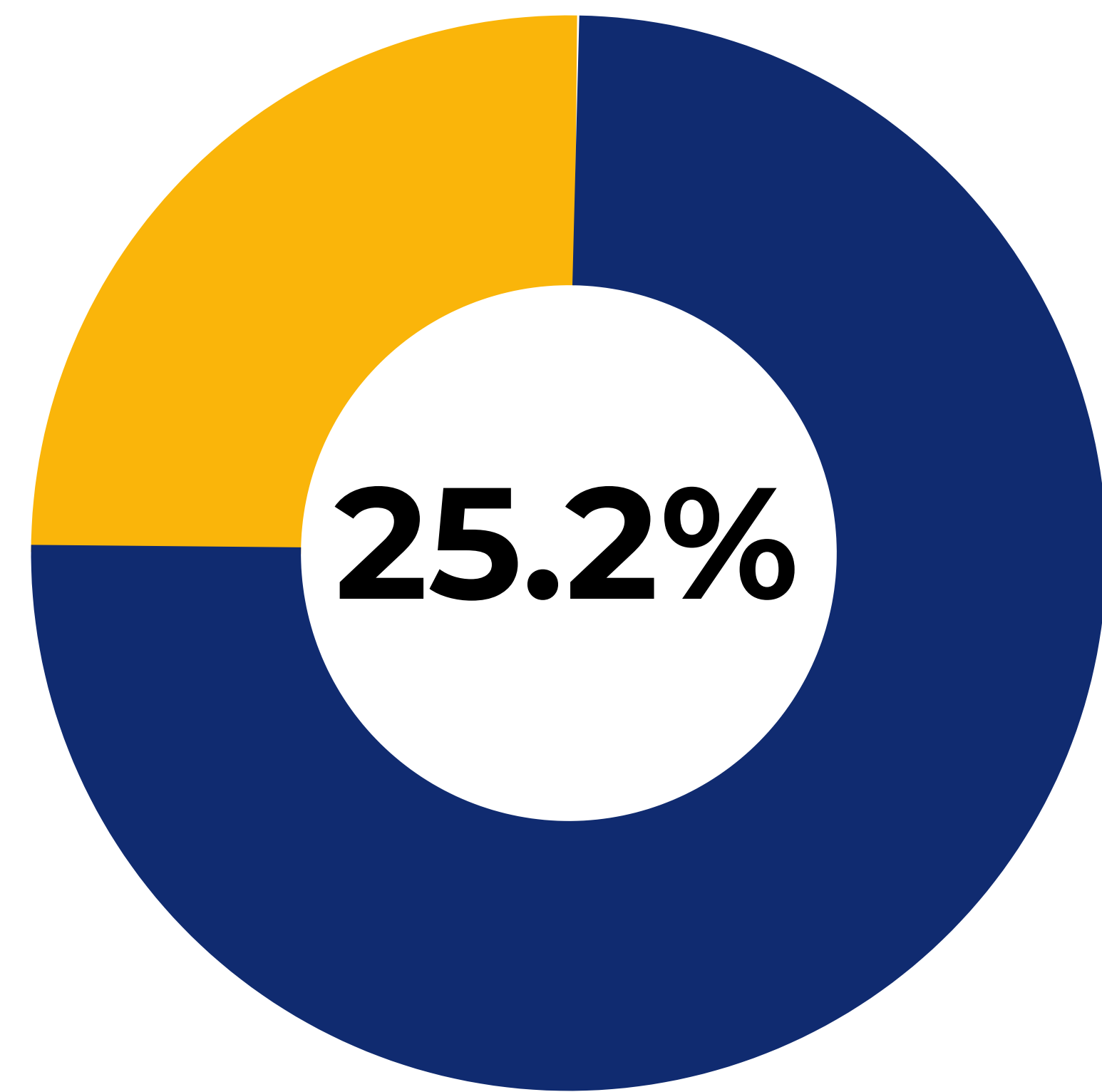
Top three taxes as a percentage of tax revenue in Trigg County

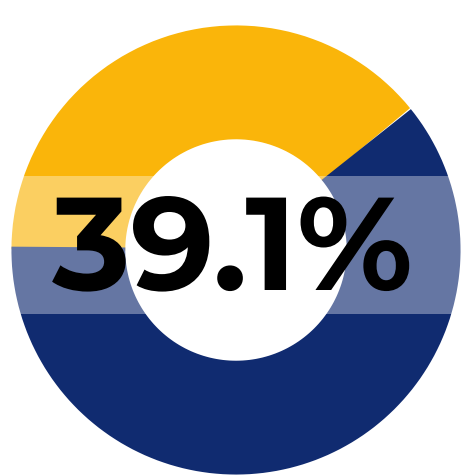

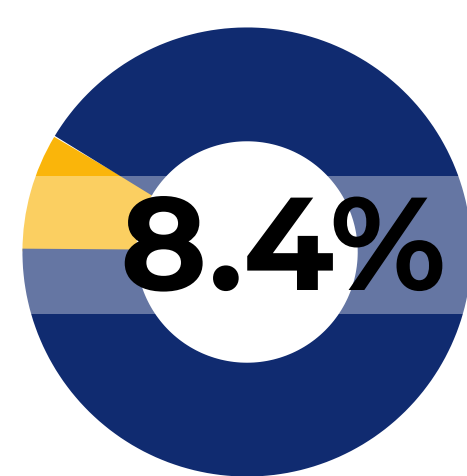
